1983-93 Ten Years

While I was well settled in England after finishing my basic and advanced training in aesthetic plastic surgery, I was called back home to join the largest Plastic Surgery unit of India namely Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research in Chandigarh India to deliver the goods that I have learned in England by then Head of the Dept. Prof. C. P. Sawhney.

PGIMER is the oldest and the largest plastic and aesthetic surgery unit of the country, and therefore the workload was tremendous in this setting. Union Territory of Chandigarh was the capital of three states, and therefore it had to be the best, and there was no paucity of funds. Several highways and extensive agriculture surrounded the town.

I was asked to establish advanced Plastic surgery facilities such as aesthetic surgery and microvascular surgery and run these units as Assist. Professor. Because of my dynamism and commitment to the discipline, I was soon promoted first to associate professor and then to professors position in these 10 years time.

One of the most severe and most extensive faciomaxillary and extremity traumas I managed and treated during this period. It was then that I invented a technique of reconstruction now called extracorporeal tissue transfer.

Being a University Hospital, it sued to cater patients from each and every medical college and from each and every town in the country of 100 million populations.

There were two professors, two additional professors, two associate and one assistant professor other than 12 senior registrars (M.Ch) and 6 MS students. A total of 24 doctors unit it was.

Only the HOD was supposed to be designated as Professor all other professors in the dept to be designated as additional Professor. I was finally promoted to additional professor.

PGI was a 600 bedded hospital then and must be much larger now. Fifty beds were allotted to plastic and aesthetic surgery unit of ours.

To teach and train the postgraduate students (preparing for Majestic chirurgical – super - specialisation) about a total of 12.

I treated around 1000 cases of aesthetic surgery and some 5000 cases of trauma during these 10 years.

Routine responsibilities included

*To plan and make purchases for the newly established discipline within plastic surgery unit.

*To prepare publications based on the dept. work on aesthetic and plastic surgery for international journals such as PRS and BJPS (American and British publications)

To present academic materials in national and international forums.

To organise, and conduct journal clubs, seminars, Planning sessions, mortality and morbidity meetings and the CME in the dept.

To teach postgraduates students

To undertake emergency cover for the unit

1978 – 1983

Period spent in England

This was a period of my introduction to England and not only to the new way of living and thinking loud but to learn, practice and perform accordingly. Main achievements during this time were the extensive training that I underwent toward advanced Aesthetic surgery procedures such as aesthetic Rhinoplasty, Facelift and Mammoplasty and their skill full application and execution.

Several training programmes like advanced Plastic surgery training course, in Oxford, and at Royal College of Surgeons in London, and the well known “flaps course” at Canniesburn Hospital in Glasgow, England were attended during this

time. Toward the later part, I used to get involved in the organising of these courses as a demonstrator.

Here I treated some 600 cases of Aesthetic Surgery and about 1000 cases of Trauma under the guidance and supervision of Prof. D. A. McGrowther and Mr R.C.Bell in the beginning and later treated them independently.

Among other projects, one of the projects that were of much use later in my life was learning the details of different flap anatomy and their execution on cadavers. This Cadaveric dissection was possible because of the easy availability of cadavers at Shotley Bridge General Hospital .Sometimes tissues like cadaveric Nerves were harvested to be sent to Canniesburn hospital for the use during Flap Course.

During this period I completed FRCS part one. I never bothered about part two since I was already well trained and fully qualified plastic and aesthetic surgeon by then, holding a good position and having a reputation in England.
